

**PERSONS WHO CAN COMPLETE SECTION 11 OF THE PASSPORT APPLICATION FORM - GUARANTORS**

The Australian Embassy may accept the Guarantor Declaration from either:

- ❖ **Section 11 (A)** - The holder of a current Australian passport with at least two years validity or
- ❖ **Section 11 (B)** - A Portuguese citizen or citizen from another country that is currently employed in one of the following occupational categories listed below.

**To qualify as a Guarantor the person must:**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No be related to the Applicant by birth or marriage</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be 18 years of age or over</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have known the Applicant for at least 12 months, or since birth for a child applicant who is under 1 years of age</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>IN BLACK INK</b> endorse the back of one photograph by writing “<b>This is a true photo of</b> (<i>Applicant’s</i> full name) and sign it</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not be in a de-facto relationship with the Applicant (this includes same sex relationships), nor live at the same address</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be able to satisfy and complete either sections 12A or 12B on the PC8 form and sign the declaration</li> </ul>
