

## **PERSONS WHO CAN COMPLETE SECTION 11 OF THE PASSPORT APPLICATION FORM - GUARANTORS**

The Australian Embassy may accept the Referee Declaration from either:

- ❖ The holder of a current Australian passport with at least two years validity or
- ❖ A Portuguese citizen or citizen from another country that is currently employed in one of the following occupational categories listed below.

### **To qualify as a Referee the person must:**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No be related to the Applicant by birth or marriage</li><li>• Have known the Applicant for at least 12 months, or since birth for a child applicant who is under 1 years of age</li><li>• Not be in a de-facto relationship with the Applicant (this includes same sex relationships), nor live at the same address</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be 18 years of age or over</li><li>• <b>IN BLACK INK</b> endorse the back of one photograph by writing "<b>This is a true photo of (Applicant's full name)</b> and sign it</li><li>• Be able to satisfy and complete either sections 11A or 11B on the PC8 form and sign the declaration</li></ul>
