

### Plan for lifting containment measures

# Update following the Council of Ministers' meeting on 15th May 2020

The following sanitary and physical distancing conditions are in place:

- 1. Availability of masks and hand sanitiser;
- 2. Regular sanitization of spaces;
- 3. Reduced maximum capacity per square meter;
- 4. Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette;
- 5. Minimum physical distancing (2 meters);
- Facial masks will be required in all public transportation, schools, shops and other indoor spaces with several individuals;
- 7. Maximum capacity of 5 individuals/100m2 in indoor spaces;
- 8. Revaluation of adopted measures between phases (every 15 days).

## PHASE 2 (starting 18th May 2020)

### Shops:

- Reopening of commercial establishments with floor area, or parts of the shop, up to 400m2;
- Municipalities can decide to open larger establishments on a case-by-case basis.

#### Restaurants:

- Reopening of restaurants, coffee shops and bakeries with a 50% maximum occupancy;
- · Reopening of outdoor terraces;
- Must follow the rules agreed between the Directorate-General of Health (DGS) and the Portuguese Association for Hotels and Restaurants (AHRESP).

## Schools:

- Reopening of secondary schools for junior and senior years and 2nd and 3rd years
  of other educational programmes (with two shifts: 10h-13h or 14h-17h)
- Protective equipment distributed to guarantee safety:
  - o 4.2 million masks;
  - o 17,000 litres of hand sanitizer;
  - o 620,000 gloves;
  - o 966,000 aprons;
  - o 22,500 protective face shields.

#### Social Facilities:

· Reopening of facilities for people with disabilities.

#### Nurseries:

· Reopening of nurseries (parents can still opt to continue at home).

23,085 tests conducted - 80% of employees already tested.

#### Culture:

- Reopening of museums, monuments, palaces, galleries, exhibition halls and similar facilities;
- Must follow rules and instructions defined by the Directorate-General of Health (DGS).

## Nursing homes:

- One visitor per person, once a week (maximum 90 min.) with prior appointment;
- Physical distancing, mask and hygiene rules.

# Religious ceremonies (planned for 30th May 2020):

 Community celebrations following rules to be agreed by the public health authorities and religious communities.

## PHASE 3 (planned for 1st June 2020)

#### Work:

· Partial teleworking, with lagged schedules and shadow teams.

#### Public services:

Reopening of "Lojas do Cidadão" (one-stop shops for public services).

### Shops and Restaurants:

- Reopening of shops with a floor area larger than 400m<sup>2</sup>;
- Reopening of shops in shopping malls.

#### Schools and Social Facilities:

Reopening of nurseries, kindergartens and day-care services.

## Culture:

 Reopening of cinemas, theatres, show rooms, and auditoriums (with limited capacity, booked seats and physical distancing).

#### Sports:

 Restart of official soccer competitions for the Primeira Liga ("Premier League") and Taça de Portugal ("National Cup") (30-31" of May).

## Beach (planned for 6th June 2020):

## Sand Stretch Usage:

- Physical distancing of 1.5m between beachgoers (who are not part of the same group);
- 3m distance between beach umbrellas;
- Sport activities with 2 or more people are forbidden (except nautical activities, surf lessons and similar sports).

## Umbrellas and tents/huts:

- Each person or group can only rent this equipment in the morning (until 1:30 pm) or in the afternoon (from 2 pm onwards);
- Maximum limit of 5 users.

## Occupation status of beaches:

- Occupation status announced through signs similar to traffic light signs:
  - o Green: low occupancy (1/3);
  - o Yellow: high occupancy (2/3);
  - o Red: full occupancy (3/3);
- Information updated continuously and in real-time on the 'Beach Info' app and on the Portuguese Environment Agency (APA) website;
- · Parking is prohibited outside car parks and other orderly parking areas.

#### General rules:

 Beach ban is a possibility, for public health reasons, in case of serious breaches by concessionaires or users.
